



Y4 HOMEWORK ROUTINES

All homework will be set via Google Classroom (GC) this year. Each pupil in class has logged onto their Hwb account over the last couple of weeks and have been able to access GC independently. They will therefore be able to do this at home. In-case pupils have mislaid their log-ins from Lockdown, they have been issued with new copies. Please ensure these are kept safe and accessible.

GC can be accessed via PC's, Mac's, smart phones and the majority of gaming consoles e.g. PS4 etc. As we know most pupils have access to at least one of these devices at home, we are confident that *all* pupils will be able to access and therefore complete their homework each week.

We recognise that not everyone has a computer at home on which they can complete homework. Therefore, each Year 4 pupil has been given an orange Homework book. Pupils can complete their homework in this book if they are unable to work on a computer.

Homework will be set on a Friday and should be returned (via GC if possible) no later than the following Wednesday. The exception to this will be the pupils weekly spellings, these will be added to GC on a Monday and should be practised ready for the following Monday.

Unfortunately, any homework completed in the pupils orange Homework book will not be able to be brought into school due to the schools Covid measures. Work completed in the orange Homework book can be photographed and added to GC for 'handing in' purposes.

Work handed in by the Wednesday will receive a teacher comment. Work handed in late will not be commented upon.
